

Citizens' Scholarship Foundation

CSF's thirty years of previous Dollars for Scholars Phonathons have received tremendous responses from Wakefield townspeople. Each year, enthusiastic high school student volunteers call thousands of Wakefield homes asking for pledges. Pledges can be made to endowment funds, as unrestricted gifts that will be combined and given as CSF General Fund awards in June or you can elect to have your donation go to where the need is greatest, in which case, your donation may be applied to either scholarships or to administrative expenses. Your pledge of \$100 will make you eligible for the Century Club. Unrestricted gifts of \$300 or more will be issued directly to a needy student as a one-time scholarship award in your name or in the name of someone you choose.

Since 1960, CSF of Wakefield has helped 7,640 Wakefield students obtain a higher education. CSF finances its grants in part from its growing endowment fund and in part from the proceeds of fundraising events. For the remainder, the Foundation depends on contributions received in response to its Annual Financial Appeal. With the cost of a college education spiraling out of control, we hope to raise even more than the \$47,043 we received from the 2010 Phonathon.

In 2010, CSF distributed \$435,000 to 269 Wakefield students. This disbursement raises the total paid out by CSF since its founding in 1960 to over \$8.4 million. All but three of the permanent endowment funds provide for awards based on need. The Boston College Academic Achievement Award, the Bill Spaulding Merit Awards and the Dan Blanchard Award are based on scholastic achievement, community and school service, and other records of excellence. There is an additional scholarship, the Rhudine Johnson Unsung Hero Award, which is awarded to a graduating Wakefield High School male and female, who are deemed "unsung heroes" by a group of his and her peers. We encourage all Wakefield residents who will be full time college students to apply for a scholarship by completing an application online at www.csfofwakefield.org.

The Citizens' Scholarship Foundation of Wakefield, Inc. now has over 559 funds of which 508 are permanent, with a total endowment of over \$10 million including accrued income. Every year scholarships are granted in the name of each Permanent Fund. CSF of Wakefield augments the awards with monies from the General Fund. Newly established permanent and accumulating funds require a minimum balance of \$5,000 to become permanent.

The Citizens' Scholarship Foundation of Wakefield, Inc. meets its expenses for rent, telephone, equipment, supplies, printing, postage, and office support by the earnings from the Joseph G. Jr. and Jean E. Sawtelle Administration Support Fund and the General Investment Reserve Fund. Together these funds amount to approximately \$1 million. In 2002, in order to ensure that CSF of Wakefield remains a significant help to local students into the 21st Century, CSF sought donations to its operating budget by actively pursuing grant money and private donations.

The Wakefield Adult Mentoring (WAM) program has been providing volunteer mentors to Wakefield public school children. The program has been a resounding success and will expand further as long as there are volunteer mentors willing to help a child in need.

Tuition at colleges and universities has increased astronomically and, even more alarming, college debt has become a staggering burden to families and students. CSF scholarships, though important, still cannot significantly defray college costs to local families. Our goal for the next century is to do even more to help Wakefield families manage the cost of post-secondary education. Thank you in advance for your support in helping us to reach this goal.
