

# The Scholarship Foundation

TSF's thirty-eight years of previous Phonathons have received tremendous responses from Wakefield townspeople. Each year, enthusiastic high school student volunteers call thousands of Wakefield homes asking for pledges. Pledges can be made to endowment funds, as unrestricted gifts that will be combined and given as TSF General Fund awards in June or you can elect to have your donation go to where the need is greatest, in which case, your donation may be applied to either scholarships or to administrative expenses. Your pledge of \$100 will make you eligible for the Century Club. Unrestricted gifts of \$500 or more will be issued directly to a needy student as a one-time scholarship award in your name or in the name of someone you choose.

Since 1960, TSF of Wakefield has presented over 11,495 financial awards to Wakefield students to assist them in obtaining a higher education. TSF finances its grants in part from its growing endowment fund and in part from the proceeds of fundraising events. For the remainder, the Foundation depends on contributions received in response to its Annual Financial Appeal. With the cost of a college education spiraling out of control, we hope to raise even more than the \$55,651 we received from the 2018 Phonathon.

In 2018, TSF distributed \$640,000 to 283 Wakefield students. This disbursement raises the total paid out by TSF since its founding in 1960 to over \$12.7 million. All but five of the permanent endowment funds provide for awards based on need. The Boston College Academic Achievement Award, the Bill Spaulding Merit Awards and the Dan Blanchard Award are based on scholastic achievement, community and school service, and other records of excellence. There is an additional scholarship, the Rhudine Johnson Unsung Hero Award, which is awarded to a graduating Wakefield High School male and female, who are deemed "unsung heroes" by a group of his and her peers. Also the Wakefield Adult Mentoring (WAM) Incentive Award offers a financial incentive to graduating students who have participated in the WAM program for at least three years and who are committed to pursue a post-secondary education/training. The Scholarship Foundation of Wakefield, Inc. now has over 603 funds of which 576 are permanent, with a total endowment of over \$11 million including accrued income. Every year scholarships are granted in the name of each Permanent Fund. TSF of Wakefield augments the awards with monies from the General Fund. Newly established permanent and accumulating funds require a minimum balance of \$10,000 to become permanent.

The Scholarship Foundation of Wakefield, Inc. meets its expenses for rent, telephone, equipment, supplies, printing, postage, and office support by the earnings from the Joseph G. Jr. and Jean E. Sawtelle Administration Support Fund and the General Investment Reserve Fund. Together these funds amount to approximately \$1 million. In 2002, in order to ensure that TSF of Wakefield remains a significant help to local students into the 21st Century, TSF sought donations to its operating budget by actively pursuing grant money and private donations.

Tuition at colleges and universities has increased astronomically and, even more alarming, college debt has become a staggering burden to families and students. TSF scholarships, though important, still cannot significantly defray college costs to local families. Our goal for the next century is to do even more to help Wakefield families manage the cost of post-secondary education. Thank you in advance for your support in helping us to reach this goal.
